

STALL HOLDER REGULATIONS

Please note that these regulations are for everyone's benefit and welfare and to ensure that the event is a happy, safe and successful for all.

We cannot allow under any circumstances traders to sell:

1. Knives or anything that could be construed as a weapon or replica weapon.
2. Any illegal substances or substances known as or referred to as legal highs.
3. Any item purporting to be official or unofficial pride merchandise of any description, or in regard to any of the artists appearing at the event.
4. Any unauthorised records, CDs, videos or tape recordings.
5. Candles, hand held flame torches, flares or wands which may constitute a fire hazard or cause injury to any person.
6. Laser pens or other laser equipment.
7. Alcoholic refreshments.
8. Items of a sexual nature, unless prior consent has been given in writing by the Pride in Gloucestershire Committee

General conditions:

1. It is essential that all stall holders have adequate fire extinguishers for their stalls. It is the stall holder's responsibility to provide their own fire safety equipment. Please advise the Trading Team on the day if this is a problem.
2. All traders must comply with local fire, health and safety regulations and with the directions of the Event Management Team. This includes rules set by the organiser.
3. No company or person will be allowed to trade on the site without prior written consent of the Pride in Gloucestershire.
4. Due to licensing restrictions no sound systems will be allowed on any stalls without prior approval in writing from Pride in Gloucestershire.
5. The sale of hot or cold food (excluding cakes and confectionery), drinks or ice cream is strictly prohibited (dealt with through having a catering pitch – separate application form and pitch price).
6. Stall holders may not distribute free publicity material outside of the event boundary.
7. Vehicle movement times and instructions must be strictly adhered to. **There will be no vehicle movement across the site after 10.45am and before 7pm (Gloucester) of 11.30am-5.15pm (Cheltenham, Cirencester, Cinderford)**, except in an emergency. No vehicle is to be parked within the event site while the event is taking place except where previous authorisation has been given and a parking permit issued.
8. You are requested to not to vacate/close prior to 7pm (Gloucester) or 5pm (Cinderford, Cheltenham, Cirencester, Tewkesbury), if unavoidable please discuss with the Stalls Co-ordinator.
9. **You are responsible for disposing of your own waste by taking it away with you when you leave.**
10. **It is essential pitches are left clean and free of all waste and materials used on the day prior to your departure, failure will result in a cleanup charge of £50.**
11. You and other people operating your stall must abide by all reasonable instructions given by event marshals and security during set, the event and take down. Any grievances should be raised with the Stalls Co-ordinator or Vice Chair via the Site Office.
12. In the event of any disputes the Vice Chair's decision is final.
